On June 22, 1831, Hugh Millen, then of Armstrong County, PA, purchased 166 acres plus 100 perches of land in Jefferson County, for \$165, from the Holland Land Company. This land was part of warrant #3029, which had been surveyed for the Holland Land Company in 1829, as part of tract of 990 acres. Hugh and Esther Millen are buried in the Beaver Run Cemetery in Rose Township, Jefferson County, PA.

Names seem to be interchanged as Millin/Millen.

Holland Land Co. conveyed 165 acres to James M Millen of Armstrong Co. September 1831.  
James M. Millen died about 1848 without a will. He owned 280 acres of land in Young Twp, Indiana Co. Land was granted in due form of law to Robert Harbison and John Millen.

1840 census of Indiana Co., Young Twp., shows James M. Millen and our William Millen living on adjoining farms.
