Notes for GEORGE MENTCH:

George W. Mentch, a leading citizen of Pennington County, is a native of Indiana County, Pennsylvania, Born on September 11, 1847, and remained in his native county until he reached the age of twenty-three being educated there and afterward following farming for a livelihood. In 1870 he moved to the neighborhood of Winfield, in southwestern Kansas, and during the next seven years was occupied in farming there. In 1877 he came to the Black Hills, arriving at Rapid City on May 17th. In December of the same year he went to the mining district around Cockerill, where he remained until the ensuing fall, when he returned to Rapid City and took up a homestead on Rapid Creek, ten miles from town. Here he engaged in farming and raising stock. He was one of the first men in this part of the state to take an active part in organizing Sunday School and church work, and during the whole period of his residence here he has been zealous and energetic in all forms of religious enterprise. For a few years lately he has been partially retired from active business pursuits, but he still retains an interest in the stock industry. From his advent into this country he has been active and forceful in local public affairs, and is regarded as one of the leading citizens of Pennington County, In politics he is a loyal and devoted Republican, and to the service of his party he has ever been a willing and helpful contributor. His first vote was cast for General Grant for President, and since casting it he has never altered in the support the party's principles and candidates. Although essentially a man of peace, he has always been ready for military service when the best interest of the country demanded it. He served in defense of the Union during the closing year of the Civil war in an independent company organized in Pennsylvania, and here in the west he has never failed to take his place in the ranks against savage fury and treachery. Last Will and Testament of Hannah Mentch

I Hannah Mench, of the Township of Cherryhill , County of Indiana, and State of Pennsylvania do hereby make and publish this my last Will and Testament, hereby making void all former wills by me at any time heretofore made.

First: I direct that my just debts and funeral expenses be fully paid.

Second: I have entered into a contract with Isaac A. Mench for a sale of my farm in Cherryhill Township, Indiana County, Pennsylvania upon the consideration that he shall furnish me a good and sufficient living and support during my life and upon my death shall pay to my executor the sum of \$2500.00 which contract is in writing and bears date of September 29, 1903, and is in the care of S. J. Telford. I hereby authorize my said executor hereinafter named to make, execute and deliver to the said Isaac A. Mench a deed for said farm. Excepting and reserving the coal and mining rights and release of damage to the surface, which deed shall be delivered to said Isaac A. Mench upon his performance of the consideration and the payment to my said executor of the sum of \$2500.00.

Third: I give devise and bequeath to Isaac A. Mench the one-sixth part of my estate less the sum of \$500.00 which I have advanced to him during my life time and which I direct shall be deducted from the said on-sixth part of my estate.

Fourth: To my son, George W. Mench, I give and devise the one-sixth part of my estate. If however, before the final settlement thereof he shall not appear and make claim thereto, then I direct that the portion of my estate bequeathed to him shall pass to his children and shall be paid to them by my executor hereinafter named share and share alike.

Fifth: To my remaining children, Mary Holmes, Ella coy, Jennie Shaw, and Frank L. Mench, I give and bequeath the remaining four-sixths of my estate share and share alike, so that each shall receive a one-sixth part thereof.

Sixth: I hereby constitute and appoint S. J. Telford executor of this my last will and Testament. In witness whereof I, Hannah Mench the testatrix above named, have hereunto subscribed my name and set my seal this 18th day of September AD 1918.

This is on my father-in-law's mothers side of the family. He had a cousin Abigail (Abbie) Roberson.....she lived not too far from him and she was always referred to as cousin Abbie. And Abbie called his mother Aunt Blanche.....Abbie's mother was Margaret Ellen Mentch born about 1857 (have Abbie's SS application with her mothers full name on it) and she was married to James Nathan Roberson. I have not been able to prove it, but decided that Margaret must have been John's sister. I do not have any information on John's parents or siblings. But looking at your file, I am wondering if the Mary Ellen you have listed as a sibling for John may have been actually Margaret Ellen.

You have a Margaret Ellen listed for John's oldest child, but no one I have found in that family knows of a Margaret Ellen as one of John's children. But see she is listed in the census record.....Hmmm. Now I am wondering of there was a secret in the family that no one told...Blanche never talked about Isaac, the oldest brother, but he died when she was just 10...so can see where she would not mention it. Sure wish someone was still alive in that part of the family who might know something.
