Beverly Nelson Rambo published a genealogy of the descendants of Peter Gunnarson Rambo in 1986. She was preparing a second edition of the Rambo Family Tree when she developed cancer. At her request I am continuing her work with the help of Peter Craig, several good genealogists, and hundreds of Rambo descendants. THANKS for your help and contributions. The manuscript will be sent to the publisher soon - perhaps within the month. This web page will give the details for purchase after the books are printed.

A MAJOR CHANGE of publication plans began in January after the professionals in Salt Lake City informed me that it is now considered UNETHICAL to publish names of living individuals without their express permission. My brother was a very private person who would have been incensed if his name had been printed in ANY book without his permission. Since I had previously stated that I would print the names of the living, I was very reluctant to change that policy, but have become convinced that ethics requires the change. Privacy is such a sticky issue.

PLEASE SEND me a list of NAMES of LIVING INDIVIDUALS who wish to see their names included in the second edition of the Rambo Family Tree. I will respond quickly to e-mail until the book goes to the printer, so you can inquire or send these names via e-mail. If a person was born after 1905 and I do not have dates of death for them and their spouse, I have to consider them living and cannot publish their names in the book. You can confirm names of the deceased with me via e-mail or by checking the following Rambo Book files for their names.

AOL was experiencing problems with overloading and system maintenance which caused this web page to be unavailable for days at a time, so I duplicated it. The alternate URLs seem to be available more often.

This version of the Rambo book files includes verbatim transcriptions of all wills prior to 1825 of all Rambo descendants in Philadelphia Co., PA.; Gloucester Co., NJ; and Salem Co., NJ. The web site is now indexed, but the index neglects parents of spouses and other people incidentally mentioned. There are more than 25,000 Rambo descendants and spouses indexed in the following files: Last names beginning A-B; C,D-E; F,G-H; I,J,K-L; M,N,O-P; Q-R; S-T; U,V,W,X,Y-Z.

The files were renumbered and reorganized in August 2002 because a few files had grown too large. There will be one more update this year after the book is published. Then I'll start working on the third edition for publication in the year 2013.

I appreciate your help. Thanks for your contributions to the Rambo Family Tree. I hope you are pleased with the results. I am continuing to research and collect information towards publication of a third edition in 2013. I NEED copies and transcriptions of wills, deeds, bible records, marriage records, etc which prove family relationships. I also NEED transcriptions and copies of biographies in county histories and of obituaries and anniversaries from local newspapers. Any "primary" and "secondary" source information of that nature which you send to me will be very much appreciated. Thanks in advance. Do NOT send attachments unless I ask you to send one. I seldom receive attachments because AOL deletes them if they are not retrieved within ten days. I can receive computer files and GEDCOMs, but prefer to accept them only for families which are not already in the book.

As Beverly did, I will attribute the sources of my information with footnotes, as should every conscientious author, including every genealogist. When you send me your family group sheets, please tell me how to word the credit to you for your information. (Read my SUGGESTIONS about the content and form of footnotes, endnotes, and attributions.) Those source citations appear in the file ENDNOTES.TXT

I'm often asked for my lineage, so can reply that I'm #112111212852: Peter Gunnarson Rambo, Gunnar, John, Mons, Andrew, Moses, George, Henry, George Washington, Cyrus Cleveland, Rex Vale, Lucille (Rambo) Beatty, and me - Ron Beatty. If you are descended from a different son or daughter of Peter Gunnarson Rambo, we are at least 11th cousins. My ancestors migrated to Somerset Co., PA before 1770; to Muskingum Co., OH in 1804; and to Van Buren Co., IA in 1853. Here's a link to my personal web site.

My e-mail provider AOL deleted all my messages while I was traveling last fall, so if you sent an e-mail between 8/2/2001 and 11/19/2001, I did not receive it. I apologize. If I have not responded to a message you sent months ago, please send me a reminder.

I have a letter from Beverly asking me to continue her work and to publish a second edition of her book, The Rambo Family Tree. I am placing this draft of the book on the web to solicit corrections and additions. If you know of errors or oversights in Beverly's book, or if you find them in the files above, please send me an e-mail with the corrections. If you have a larger collection of data or a GEDCOM file, DO NOT send it as an attachment. I seldom receive them. Please read my SUGGESTIONS before sending your files.

If you care about the disposition of your genealogical materials, PROVIDE FOR THEM IN YOUR WILL. Otherwise you can kiss it goodbye. Between 1986 and 1990, Beverly had accumulated much more information about the Rambo families and was preparing to publish a revision. She asked me to continue her work. I arrived in Los Angeles to discuss that with her .. the day after she died. Her sister always says that she will send Beverly's Rambo materials to me, but in fact has been a "stone wall," promising anything over the phone but doing nothing. I believe that the majority of Beverly's collection was destroyed when her brother moved, so am compiling information without the aid of Beverly's work.

If you use MSN to do a search for "Rambo Family Tree", you will find a very good site by David A. Rambo on familytreemaker.com.

However, always be skeptical no matter whose material you use (even Beverly's and mine). Anything published contains errors and often contains speculation which is masqueraded as fact. Until you have seen "proof" in "original documents" (such as wills, deeds, court records, family bibles, or the like), all you have is hearsay, one step removed from rumors and speculation.
